### **Position Description**

#### **Overview**

The Swimming Club Captain is a respected leadership role entrusted to a swimmer who demonstrates commitment, sportsmanship, and pride in representing the club. The Swim Captain/s supports the development of a positive club culture, acts as a role model for all members, and contributes to the smooth running of club activities and events.

#### **Key Responsibilities**

##### **1. Represent the Club with Pride**

- Attend and represent the club at official functions, presentations, and community events.
- Wear the club uniform with pride, demonstrating professionalism and respect for the club's values.
- Promote a positive and inclusive environment for swimmers of all ages and abilities.

##### **2. Lead and Communicate at Club Events**

- Speak confidently at club functions, presentations, and special events when required.
- Encourage and motivate swimmers, fostering team spirit and supporting club initiatives.
- Act as a liaison between swimmers, coaches, and committee members when appropriate.

##### **3. Support Club Operations and Squad Development**

- Assist with marshalling duties on race days to ensure events run smoothly and efficiently when applicable.
- Provide support and encouragement to the Developmental Squad and Ken Rich Squad when applicable, helping younger swimmers feel welcomed and supported.
- Demonstrate leadership through positive behaviour, reliability, and a strong work ethic.

## Selection Criteria

Applicants for the role of Swimming Club Captain should demonstrate:

- **Minimum age of 15 years** at the time of appointment.
- Strong communication skills and confidence speaking at club events.
- A positive attitude, strong sense of sportsmanship, and commitment to club values.
- Willingness to represent the club at official functions and community events.
- Reliability and responsibility in assisting with marshalling and supporting squad activities.
- Ability to act as a role model for younger swimmers and contribute to a supportive team environment.
- Consistent attendance at training sessions and club events.
